

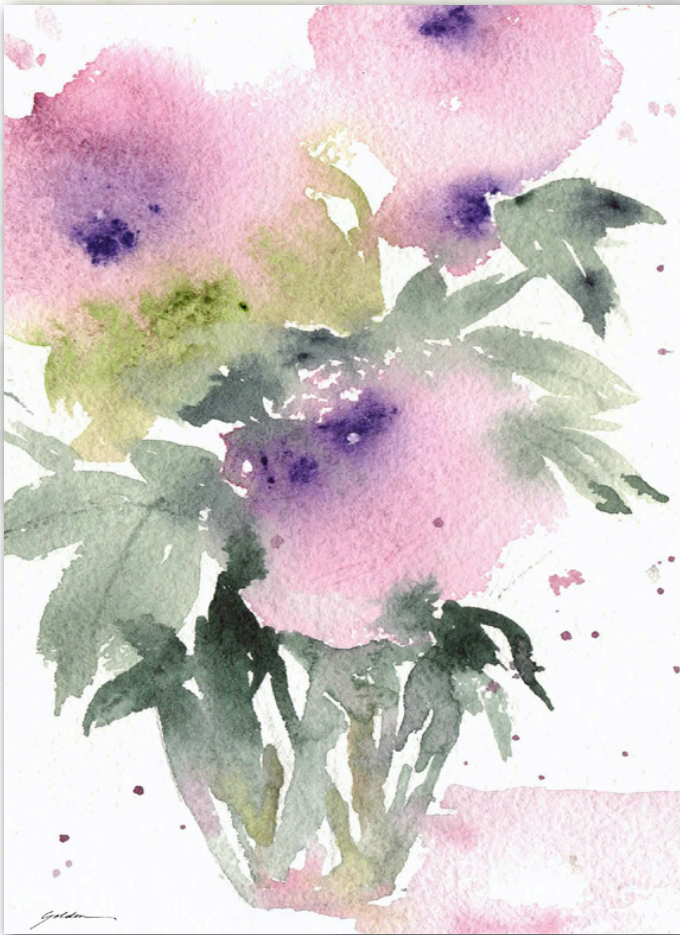

# Supply List Watercolor Glass Vase with Flowers

## Advanced:

- Bring your watercolors
- 1 sheet or pad: Watercolor Cold Press paper 140 lb. Arches if possible.
- A selection of round and flat brushes
- Drawing pencil

## Beginners:

Please have your watercolor paint tubes open and unsealed before the class.

- Round Brushes: 10 & 12
- Flat large paintbrush
- Watercolor paper: 140 lb. high quality paper
- 1 sheet or small pad
- Drawing pencil
- A few tubes of watercolor. (Red, yellow, green, blue and black.) Do not buy opaque gouache, a water-based paint. We will learn about mixing colors in the class.
- White ceramic plate as palette for mixing. Sheila will provide paper plates if you do not have a mixing plate or palette.

Watercolor palettes hold colors- separate from mixing plate.

The paint blobs remain in the palette when you leave class.
